## What is Talent RISE?

## What is RISE Day?

Every year in early September we make an extra special push to **help young people with their job search or career progression** by offering them **free advice and mentoring from one of over 350 volunteers** from Talent International.

This year we're starting early. Between now and September 9, **we want to connect 100 young people (aged 18-30) in the UK with our incredible volunteers who are all friendly, recruitment experts.**

# RISE Day 2022: A Step-by-Step Guide

## 1. Sign-Up

Sign-up online via the link below  
OR give your info to your youth  
worker / job-coach:

We just ask for your name, email,  
phone, age and location. We'll  
never share your info beyond our  
team without your permission.

## 2. Intro Call (10 mins) & Survey

We'll give you a quick call to  
understand your interests and how  
our team can best help you.

We'll ask you to send your CV and fill in  
a survey. This is so we can create a  
report to encourage employers to offer  
more opportunities to young people.  
See [this example](#) from last year. **Data  
will be anonymised unless we have  
your explicit permission to share.**

## 3. Intro to Recruitment Pro

Once we have your CV (don't  
worry if you don't have one) and  
survey, we'll connect you via  
email to a recruitment pro who  
volunteers with Talent RISE.

## 4. Schedule your Call

Once connected you can then  
book a 45-minute call for a date /  
time that suits (from now until  
Sep 9, 2022)

You can do this via a simple form  
or simply by chatting/emailing  
with the volunteer.

## 5. Attend Your Call

You can have your call via phone  
or MS Teams. We'll send you a  
helpful reminder in advance.

We understand things come up  
and you can reschedule for  
another date / time if needed.

## 6. The Journey Continues

Our volunteers and wider team would  
love to keep helping you moving  
forward (although there's no  
obligation if a one-off is all you  
need/want).

If wanted you can receive alerts about  
opportunities with employers, etc, and  
receive a free login to [Skillsoft](#) so you  
can upskill online and at your own  
pace.

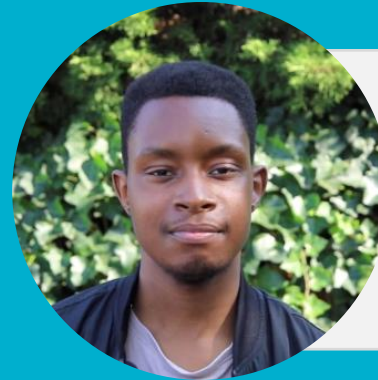

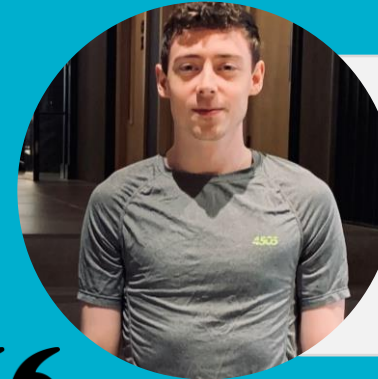
