| 2               | Holiday-time provisions; various hours to suit, whole days or half-days between 9am - 6pm in school holidays only.   | Assistant support workers for Bristol Autism Project; delivering activities across Bristol for autistic children aged 4-18 and their parents/carers and siblings (e.g. arts/crafts, swimming, climbing, bowling, cooking, forestry, and much more.)  |
| 2               | Holiday-time provisions, between 9am - 4pm in school holidays  | Leaders in charge and Assistant youth support workers required across Frampton Cotterell, Patchway, and Filton, to provide daytime youth work activities; including sports, cooking, crafts, trips, etc. 2-3 days p/week during holidays.  |
| 2*              | Bank staff - covering new projects, holidays, and sickness as and when needed  | Across sites in Bristol (Southmead & Easton), and South Glos (Filton, Kingwood, Patchway, and Frampton Cotterell), as well as holiday-time provisions.<br><i>(could be an average 3-6 hrs p/week all year round)</i>   |
